

BACKGROUND

- The 2020 APC season is open and will end on 31 December 2019
- The National Department of Health, together with the major trade unions in the Public Health and Social Development Sectoral Bargaining Council (PHSDSBC), have signed Resolution 3 of 2019
- This Resolution brings into effect the Persal deductions for all affected employees that fall under the PHSDSBC
- The collation of information is currently is in progress

STATUS

- All the Provinces have been informed about the implementation of Persal Deductions for the 2020 APC season
- The following Departments have already submitted:
 - Gauteng Provincial Health Department;
 - KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Health Department;
 - KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Social Development;
 - North West Provincial Health Department;
 - North West Provincial Social Development;
 - Free State Provincial Health Department;

STATUS

- The following Departments have already submitted (continued):
 - Eastern Cape Provincial Department of Health;
 - Northern Cape Provincial Health Department; and
 - Western Cape Provincial Health Department.
- Contact has been made with Mpumalanga Provincial Department of Health and they have promised to submit soon (Mr Khalishwayo)
- The Limpopo Department of Health has failed to respond to our requests for submission, currently we are not certain whether they will submit or not

CHALLENGES

 The following were the key issues that were encountered during the verification of data:

- Nurse deceased;
- ID number invalid;
- Nurse removed non-payment;
- Nurse not registered;
- Nurse number invalid; and
- Nurse removed own request

WAY FORWARD

- Persal deductions for the provinces that have submitted already to be submitted by the relevant departments to National Treasury to effect the deductions
- The first batch of payments is expected to go through on the 15th of November 2019
- The last batch of deductions will go through on the 15th of December 2019
- All employees that had already paid at the time the reports were run, were excluded from the list of Persal deductions
- There are, however, certain challenges that the provinces have been requested to attend to

CONCLUSION

- Provinces are responsible for submission and investigation of all anomalies
- The final date for receiving payments remains 31 December 2019
- Nurse practitioners are responsible for ensuring the payments are received on time
- The delivery of the APCs to be arranged with each province
- Nurse practitioners are requested to update their details on the registe
